All Competitions will be adjudicated by 3 adjudicators excluding the U9 Competition which will be only 1 adjudicator. Solo rounds will be judged by an extra adjudicator during the championships. Soft shoe round will be first. There will be a choice of contemporary set for any dancer in age U12 or older.

Registration Info

Entries are open on <a href="www.wefeis.com">www.wefeis.com</a>. Entries Close on midnight of May 20th or once we reach our cap of 250. Late entries accepted until May 31 unless our cap is reached before that. No Refund on entries for any reason. Entries are non-transferrable. Teams will be entered by one dancer on the team and will charged for the entire team. Team entries do not apply to a family max.

Family Max is \$200 not including the Teams, Entrance fee and any late or change fees that incur.

#### An Chomhdhail Rules

- Age Groups up to and including U9 and prohibited from wearing a solo costume. This
  includes championship levels.
- Dancers in Pre Cup, Bun Grad A, B and C are all prohibited from wearing solo costumes.
- Competitions for age groups up to and including U11 are not permitted after 6pm.
- Children up to and including the age of 12 are prohibited from wearing face make up.
- All dancers are prohibited from wearing any form of glitter on their face.
- In Bun Grad A, B and C there must be a minimum of 10 competitors and in the Pre Open Competitions there must be a minimum of 5 competitors before the winner must progress to the next grade. If there are less than these minimum numbers, it is at the discretion of the Adjudicator to issue an award or an actual 1st place WIN, based on the standard rather than the number in the competition. Dancer must progress to the next level in that dance if the win is given. An award means you can stay in your level.
- Competitors are required to be appropriately dressed at all times while attending the feis. The committee has the right to make sure this rule is adhered to.
- All Competitors must wear their number positioned center front, clearly displayed for adjudicators. NO PLASTIC COVERS ALLOWED.
- Once a dancer has won 1st prize in a competition, they are not eligible for that dance in that particular grade for forthcoming competitions, even if entries have been pre-paid.
- There are no arm movements or clapping allowed in Treble Reel and it must be a full step danced on right and left.
- In the event of an injury at the feis, an incident report should be made stating how the injury happened and the course of action that was taken.
- Any form of unauthorized photography which captures a dancer's image whilst taking part in the competition is expressly forbidden. This covers photography by means of mobile phones, tablets, video camera with or with out flash capability.
- Under health and safety, dancers are asked not to smoke whilst dressed in their costume.
- All dancers must show up to awards in full costume, including but not limited to shoes and dress.
- The decision for the adjudicator (s) is final as to quality. An objection on any other grounds may be lodged by a teacher only in writing on payment of a fee of \$10. The feis committee may adjudicate on such an objection if they consider themselves competent to do so, and will return the objection to the Executive of An Chomhdhail. No objection will be considered unless it is made in writing within 48 hours after the declaration of the result of the competition. Any teacher who disagrees with the decision of the feis committee may refer the matter to the Executive of An Chomhdhail on payment of a fee of 20 Euros or equivalent.

# General Regulations and Guidelines

Parent/guardian and Dancer agrees to abide by all An Chomhdhail, USA IDA, and venue rules and regulations. The USA IDA will not be held responsible for any personal injury, property loss or damage. Destruction of feis property will be punishable by law. Parents are responsible for damages done by their children. Upon payment of entry fees, I am granting permission for the feis to use any pictures. videos and results posting on social media.

By registering for the feis, I acknowledge that this activity involves exertion and carries with it the potential for injury. I hereby agree to waive the right to take legal action or join in any actions against USA Irish Dance Alliance, Inc. the board members and/or any affiliates and associates for injuries incurred during practice and/or performance in any location. I hereby agree to indemnify, protect and save harmless the parties above or any of them from all judgments, cost and expenses whatsoever arising on account of any action, claim or demand by the minor child of mine, or any child for which I am acting in guardianship or supervisory capacity. It is understood and agreed that the participant is physically fit and prepared for participation in the activities which will be undertaken, and the participant has not been advised by any doctor or other medical person that participation in these activities should be avoided and/or limited. Participation in any competition or performance is at the sole discretion and decision of the parent. I hereby give permission to the school and the parties to use my name and/or my child's name, photographic likeness in all forms and media for advertising, trade and any other lawful purpose without any remuneration. The feis has the right to refuse any entry for any reason.
